The Association of Chinese Cooking Teachers (ACCT) is a 501(c)3 educational non-profit corporation. We promote the cuisines and cultures of Asia and provide a forum for food professionals, culinary students, food purveyors and all food enthusiasts to network and exchange information and ideas.

ACCT was founded in 1982 by a small group of dedicated Chinese cooking teachers who wanted to share ideas and their expertise about Chinese food and cooking methods. ACCT has grown to include anyone who has a strong interest in Asian foods and cultures. Our membership includes restaurateurs, chefs, caterers, cooking instructors, food writers, cookbook authors, culinary educators, graphic designers, stylists, retailers, and travel consultants as well as anyone who enjoys cooking Asian food and loves gourmet dining. Members reside throughout the San Francisco Bay Area and coastal regions. Out-of-area members hail from Houston, Boston, Seattle and New York City.
